July 2015

July 2, 2015

- An article published in the *Fort Mill Times* referenced the town's receipt of a Federal Historic Preservation Grant from SCDHAH and provided a brief overview of the Historic District Design Guidelines project.

July 21, 2015

- Planning Director Cronin sent an email to Brad Sauls at 3:37 PM informing SCDHAH that Town Manager Pieper had no concerns with the draft Funding Agreement. Two copies of the agreement will be signed by SCDHAH and sent to the town for execution.

August 2015

August 1, 2015

- The town's Historic Preservation Grant award was highlighted in the "Mayor's Corner" section of the August/September edition of *My Carolina Town* magazine.

August 19, 2015

- The 2015 Federal Historic Preservation Grant Funding Agreement was signed by Town Manager Pieper. An original copy of the Funding Agreement was mailed to SCDHAH via USPS. A second copy was placed in the project file in the Planning Department.

- Planning Director Cronin received an email from Brad Sauls at 11:12 AM with a draft version of the Request for Proposals (RFP) for the Town of Fort Mill Historic District Design Guidelines Project.

- Fort Mill Town Council gave second reading approval to the FY 2015-16 Budget Ordinance. The budget included an appropriation in the amount of \$50,000.00 for completion of the Town of Fort Mill Historic District Design Guidelines Project.
