

- **Fort Mill Southern Bypass (Phase 2)**
 - Program: Pennies 2 (2003)
 - Project Type: New Road Alignment (2 Lane)
 - Location: Holbrook Road to SC 160
 - Budget: \$23.99 million
 - Status: Under Construction (85% Complete)
 - Est. Completion: Summer 2016



- **Spratt Street Realignment**

- Program: Pennies 3 (2011)
- Project Type: Intersection Realignment
- Location: Fort Mill Parkway & Spratt Street
- Budget: \$4.75 million
- Status: Design and permitting; ROW acquisition to begin in Fall 2016
- Est. Completion: 2018



- Spratt Street Realignment





- **I-77 @ Gold Hill Road Interchange**

- Program: Pennies 3 (2011)
- Project Type: Interchange Improvement
- Location: I-77 & Gold Hill Road
- Budget: \$11.65 million
- Status: Received design comments from SCDOT; ROW acquisition to begin in Spring 2016
- Est. Completion: 2019



 - Est. Completion: 2021



 - Status: Design and permitting; ROW acquisition to begin in Summer 2016
 - Est. Completion: 2019



Pennies for Progress Projects

- **US 21 Bypass & SC 51**
 - Program: Pennies 3 (2011)
 - Project Type: Multilane Widening (5 Lanes)
 - Location: Springfield Parkway to SC 51 (US 21) & US 21 to NC State Line (US 51)
 - Budget: \$22.43 million
 - Status: Design and permitting; ROW acquisition to begin in Summer 2016
 - Est. Completion: 2020






Pennies for Progress

 - Projected Revenue: \$225 +/- Million

 - Location TBD





- Whites Road







