About the UDO Advisory Committee

On December 8, 2014, the Fort Mill Town Council approved a contract with LSL Planning for the development of a new Unified Development Ordinance (UDO) for the town of Fort Mill, and authorized staff and the Planning Commission initiate the process to prepare a UDO for council's review and approval. The UDO Advisory Committee will include the seven (7) members of the Fort Mill Planning Commission, as well as the chairperson of the town's Board of Zoning Appeals and Historic Review Board. Members from each town department will also assist the committee in an advisory capacity. The committee will be tasked with providing input, guidance and feedback to town staff and the consultant during the development of a new UDO, and will make its final recommendations to Town Council in early 2016.
